


- Top-line update: MCC has elected to renew our club-level membership with US Rowing

REFRESHER: TYPES OF VOLUNTEER ROLES

Operational positions: work over a period of time or the entire season

One-time volunteer positions: 2-4 hour shifts during fundraising events, regattas, etc. These sign-ups will come later in the season.

If you signed up for an operational position and you are a new parent, please reach out to the board member who oversees that position.

- Event signups will start in January and continue through May.

- Chuck Wagon Manager (primarily for Away Regattas)



- 3rd installment = Apr 15, 2025 (included reductions for all fundraising, including mulch)

- Mandatory Swim Test: Sunday, January 26 at Spring Hill Rec Center, 4 PM
 - This is for athletes who are NEW to McLean Crew. If your athlete participated in the Fall 2024 Learn To Row program, this swim test is not required.
- Annual All Boat Dinner: 7:00-9:00 on Friday, March 28, 2025, McLean High School Cafeteria
- FCPS Volunteer Badging: Final request for the 2025 season will be submitted on Friday, January 10.

FCPS VOLUNTEER BADGING PROCESS

FCPS Badging is a multistep process involving at least 5 emails from McLean High School Athletics Office and FCPS HR. IF YOU HAVE QUESTIONS ABOUT THE PROCESS, please contact Kristen Kucko on Slack or email memberatlarge@mcleancrew.org and not Stefanie Evers in the MHS Activities Office. There are 50 MCC volunteers seeking badges, MCC does not want to overwhelm the MHS Activities Office.

STEP 1 Once MCC submitted volunteer names to McLean High School Athletics Office, you will receive the first email requiring you to register for a Candidate Reference Number

STEP 2 – Email Invitation to complete the online FCPS Onboarding process immediately.

You will receive an email from FairfaxCountyPublicSchools@brassring.com DoNotReply@brassring.com with a unique link* to set your password to the FCPS Onboarding portal, within 24 hours of receiving this message. This email will also contain your username and instructions to help you through the process of setting up your account. Please check Junk mail if the message is not in your inbox within 24 hours.

Once you set your password and finish setting up your account, you must complete the additional Onboarding tasks and trainings accessed through this link.

STEP 3 - Schedule an appointment (received via email) to visit the FCPS administration center for fingerprinting.

You will receive an email invitation to schedule an appointment to get fingerprinted for completion of a criminal background check once you have completed the Onboarding tasks.

STEP 4— Arrive to your scheduled fingerprint appointment.

*The onboarding link you receive is **time sensitive**, so please let me or <u>HR Client Services</u> know if the email is not in your Inbox or Junk mail within 24 hours. Candidates who do not complete the Onboarding process, including fingerprinting, within 90 days may be dispositioned and will have to complete the process again, from scratch.

If you have any trouble completing your Onboarding tasks, you can contact HR Client Services at 571-423-3000 or through StaffConnect.

STEP 5- FCPS HR sends email with approval decision. If approved, badge will be sent to MCC via the MHS Activities Office. MCC will get the badge to you at the next Membership Meeting

ERGATHON 2025

- Mandatory fundraiser on Sat, Feb 8, 2025 (Inclement weather date: Feb 15)
- Funds raised through donations from family and friends prior to Ergathon and from the public the day of Ergathon
 - 60% of donations received pre-Ergathon reduce dues up to maximum of \$1,450 credit (maximum is across all fundraisers)
 - 100% of funds raised day of Ergathon go to MCC
- Every athlete completes 3-hour shift: 2.5 hours soliciting donations & 0.5 hours erging in front of McLean downtown businesses and on strategic corners



ERGATHON SIGNUPS

- Sign Ups coming soon!
 - All Athletes sign up for 3-hour shift
 - Will need 24-28 parent volunteers to sign up to supervise check-ins, solicitation, and cash collected, and to haul ergs
- All pledge sheets and money collected pre-Ergathon should be given to Ergathon lead, Cara Crumpler prior to the start of shift.





MULCH

- March 1- 2nd
- (Snow date March 15-16th)
- Attendance is mandatory both Saturday and Sunday for athletes
- At least one parent is required to volunteer for at least one day
- Leads and a ton of information sent out 12/19/24!
- Goal of 16,500 mulch bags
- SUGs coming soon!



MULCH MADNESS SIGN UPS

1) Mandatory Parent Sign Up: One Parent, One day, Mar 1 or 2, ALL day until job is done. Does not count towards volunteer credits.

- 2) Extra Credit Parent Sign Up: Optional jobs, counts towards volunteer credit. In addition to mandatory job.
- 3) <u>Supplies Sign Up:</u> Save MCC money by lending supplies.
- 4) Food Sign Up: Save MCC money by donating food.
- 5) Chase Car Sign Up: Athletes sign up for a car group. This sign up comes out after mandatory parent jobs are filled.


