


MCLEAN CREW CLUB GENERAL MEMBERSHIP MEETING

SPRING SEASON EXPECTATIONS

- Daily attendance at practice is expected, including Spring Break
- Boatings are done based on athletic ability (to include technique), attitude, and attendance. Coaches have the final say. Decisions are not personal, but meant to make the best boats possible.
- Tryouts are 2/24-2/26. Athletes need to attend if they would like to be considered for the team. Cuts are expected to happen.
- 1V8+ and 2V8+ athletes rowing in championship events at VSRC (States) earn varsity letters
- Stotesbury is attended by select boats only
- National Competition is attended by those boats that qualify using a qualification rubric. The 1V must qualify for any other boat to attend.
- Athletes have access to current data so know where they are on the team.







MULCH

- Final weekend for sales! Store closes Feb 17 or when we hit max limit!
- Cash donations are an option & very welcome (60% counts towards dues credit)!
- March 1- 2nd delivery weekend
- (Snow date March 15-16th)
- Attendance is mandatory both
 Saturday and Sunday for athletes
- At least one parent is required to volunteer for at least one day
- \$1,000 charge if family member doesn't fulfill mandatory mulch role!
- Mulch bag sales and mulch cash donations will credit 3rd dues payment

MULCH MADNESS SIGN UPS

- Mandatory Parent Sign Up: One Parent, One day,
 Mar 1 or 2, ALL day until job is done. Does not count towards volunteer credits.
- Extra Credit Parent Sign Up: Optional jobs, counts towards volunteer credit. In addition to mandatory job.
- Supplies Sign Up: Save MCC money by lending supplies.
- Food Sign Up: Save MCC money by donating food.
- <u>Chase Car Sign Up:</u> Athletes sign up for a car group. This sign up comes out after mandatory parent jobs are filled.

PRACTICE SCHEDULE

- 3pm 7pm Door to Door (MHS to MHS)
 - Training 3:30-6:30ish (times vary with sunset) Buses depart TBC approximately 6:30-6:45 to return to MHS


